

## Maths A Level Preparation Work

Welcome to Reigate Grammar School and congratulations on choosing to study Maths in the Sixth Form. You have probably been told that there is a big jump between GCSE and A Level, and this is certainly true of Mathematics. Details of these specific questions can be found on the information page of the booklet. If you are also taking Further Maths as an A Level, then there is an extra section of the booklet for you to complete as well.
