

Notes To Accompany School Exam Timetables

Pupil Version

First Form

- Exams will take place in normal lessons. Your Form's exam timetable shows you which lessons are exam periods;
- Exams will be 40mins long;
- Exams will be over 4 days, Monday to Thursday, and you will be going on a school trip on the Friday;
- There will be no assemblies during exam week so Period 1 can start at 8.40;
- Some exams might start a bit earlier or run a bit later than the normal lesson times. Your teacher will tell you if this is the case;
- If you have special exam arrangements, you will get a personalised timetable via their school email and a copy will also be sent to your form tutor;
- Lesson 6A will start at 1.30pm.

Second Form

- Exams will take place in normal lessons. Your Form's exam timetable shows you which lessons are exam periods;
- Exams will be 1 hour long or split into 2 x 30 minute papers;
- Exams are spread over 5 days, Monday to Friday;
- There will be no assemblies during exam week so Period 1 can start at 8.40;
- Some exams might start a bit earlier or run a bit later than the normal lesson times. Your teacher will tell you if this is the case;
- If you have special exam arrangements, you will get a personalised timetable via their school email and a copy will also be sent to your form tutor.

Third and Fourth Year

- These exams are in the locations indicated on the timetable;
- Exams are 1.5 hours long;
- Exams during Period 1 will include about 25 minutes study and the exam needs to start about 9.30. It should end about 11. By the time all the papers are collected in, you will be released about 11.10am;
- You will need to be at the location of your 2nd exam by 11.35 as we need a prompt start;
- You will need to be at the location of your afternoon exam by 2.10pm as you need to be registered;
- If you have a slot without an exam in you are to go to the library;

- If you have special exam arrangements will get a personalised timetable via their school email and a copy will also be sent to your form tutor.
